Local Initiatives

Rural Night of Action – On 10th and 11th April Chester Local Policing Unit carried out a Rural Nights of Action being proactive in combating various potential rural crime activities and providing visibility to the local community of Police involvement at all times of the day.

Operation Shield – Last month over 500 properties in Tattenhall Parish received Selecta DNA marking kits and it is hoped that ever property will have received a kit by mid-June.

Bike Security Marking – 2 successful bike marking sessions were held last month in Tattenhall and Malpas, over 75 bikes were security marked.

Speeding - On-going attention has been given to speeding on the A49 at Beeston and Tiverton and on the B5069 Wrexham Road between Malpas and Threapwood.
