Rector's Easter Letter: Despite the cold and inconvenience, I think there is something beautiful about a pristine, undisturbed heavy snowfall.

The journey through Lent can feel like a snowfall. A strange time of waiting, of cleansing, of pausing and reflecting while we wait to celebrate Easter and the new life that burst forth from the darkness of the tomb: life that overcame death and gives us hope and a new life in the risen Christ. That first Easter morning was, as NT Wright says "the decisive event demonstrating that God's kingdom really has been launched on earth as it is in heaven" a kingdom we are invited to be part of.

As I look out of my window and see the delicate crocuses and daffodils swaying in the breeze I know that the real work by them was done hidden underground in the dark and cold and it is only because of that work that we can see their beauty and colour today. The real work of Christ was also hidden – it was not just His work on the cross that mattered, but His work hidden in the dark, cold, loneliness of the tomb. Because it is Jesus' resurrection not his death that brings us hope and new life.

As we move through Lent I encourage you to use this time in prayer and reflection – to see this time as an opportunity to dig deep in prayer and mediation and to invite God to work in you, preparing you for Easter and the celebration of that new life offered to us through Jesus' resurrection. For, as we read in 2 Corinthians: "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!"

Alleluia. Christ is risen **Rev. Janine**







Behind the Scenes in the Bell Tower

In the March edition of Parish News we looked mainly at the physical side of bell ringing. In this article we're going to delve a little deeper into the mental exercise that bell ringing offers.

Let me briefly remind you that each bell is numbered in sequence from the highest note (1) to the lowest note (8). Take a look at figure 1. This shows the simplest

pattern or method of change ringing known as a plain hunt. The position of each bell is joined up by a continuous coloured line. Each row represents one pull of the bell rope. If you follow the line that joins all the 1's you'll see that it gradually moves from the first column to the last column and then back to the first column.

There are 3 things to notice:

Each bell follows the same shaped line but starts in a different place No bell stays in the same column for more than 2 rows

All the rows are different

Ringing this pattern on St Oswald's bells would take about 10 seconds. Now take a look at figure 2. This shows a much more complicated pattern / method known as Cambridge Surprise Major. The bell numbers are not shown but as with the plain hunt, the position of each bell is shown by a different coloured line. The same 3 things apply but this method would continue for 224 rows.

To extend the number of rows even further, the conductor (the lead member of the band) will call out some minor variations every few minutes which will enable the band to ring more than 5000 different changes without repeating any.

This is known as a peal. Memorising the pattern / method and not letting your attention wander for 3 hours or so is why bell ringing is such a powerful mental exercise.

If you want to see a local example of this, take a look at figure 3 or the peal boards hanging in the ringing chamber at St Oswalds on a practice night or before the Sunday morning service.

Flourless Chocolate and Almond Cake



Ingredients

200g dark cooking chocolate, chopped into small pieces

200g butter, chopped into small pieces

3 eggs

175g golden caster sugar

100g mascarpone or soft cheese

1/4 tsp vanilla extract

100g ground almonds

30g cocoa powder, plus extra to serve

Many people have asked for this gluten free chocolate cake recipe—
totally delicious, though slightly

STEP 1

Heat the oven to 180C/160C fan/gas 4 and line the base of a 20cm springform tin with baking parchment. Melt the chocolate and butter in a heatproof bowl set over a pan of just-simmering water, or in the microwave in 20-second bursts. Stir, then leave to cool slightly.

STEP 2

Meanwhile, tip the eggs and sugar into a second bowl and beat with an electric whisk for 4-5 mins, or until thick and creamy. Add the mascarpone or soft cheese and vanilla, and continue to beat until everything is combined. Lightly fold in the cooled melted chocolate mixture until everything is one even colour, then fold in the almonds. Sift over the cocoa powder and a small pinch of salt, and fold in to combine.

STEP 3

Scrape the cake batter into the prepared tin. Put the tin on a baking tray and bake for 35-40 mins until the cake is puffed up and has cracked on top.
