

Renewal of the Electoral Roll



# **Small Groups**

Share life and grow in faith together

Small groups meet together and provide space for deep connections and community to form through shared prayer, worship, and bible study.

Lent Small Group taster sessions 25th March, 1st April, 8th April and 15th April **Lent theme:** This year, the Lent theme for the Church Of England is Living Hope. The resources explore how we can have hope in times of frustration or uncertainty; the hope found in joining with others; the invitation to notice signs of hope around us; the courage to face reality and pursue a hopeful future; and the ways God transforms death into life at Easter.

**Lent Study Groups:** As part of that journey, we will be running 4 Lent Bible Study sessions during Lent. Sessions run at St Oswald's at 2:00pm and at Holy Trinity at 7:00pm on the following dates: 25th March, 1st April, 8th April and the 15th April.

## The Lily by William Blake


The modest Rose puts forth a thorn:
