Killed in action; France 30<sup>th</sup> October 1914 Aged 29

Buried in Pont-du-Hem Military Cemetery, La Gorgue, Nord, France

**Frederick Bateman** Rifleman No. 4302

1st/8th Battalion London Regiment (Post Office Rifles)

Killed in action; France 21 May 1916 Aged 29

Commemorated on Arras Memorial, Pas de Calais, France

South Wales Borderers, posted to 2nd Battalion Monmouthshire Regiment

Killed in action; France 16 January 1917 Aged 21

Commemorated on Thiepval Memorial

Died of wounds; France 9 May 1918 Aged 34

Buried in Senlis Communal Cemetery Extension, Somme, France

Died of wounds; France 31 March 1918 Aged 32

Buried in Namps-au-Val British Cemetery, France

13th Battalion Welsh Regiment

Died in an accident; UK 21 September 1919 Aged 20

Buried in Pembroke Dock Military Cemetery

**Thomas Boycott** Private No. 18499

C Company 7th Battalion King's Shropshire Light Infantry

Killed in action; France 14 July 1916 Aged 22

Commemorated on Thiepval Memorial

**William John Brellisford** Private No. 48750

6th Battalion Royal Inniskilling Fusiliers (formerly 32767 Cheshire Regiment)

Died of wounds; France 16 November 1918 Aged 36

Buried in Premont British Cemetery, Aisne, France

**John Henry Burns** Gunner No. 3917 (although shown as 1917 on the CWGC site)

'X' 4th <sup>TM</sup> Battery Royal Field Artillery

Died; UK 1 May 1920 Aged 25

Buried in Whitchurch Cemetery, Shropshire

**James Caughan** Private No. 14403 (*James was the brother of Patrick Gaughan, who was killed in action in 1917.*)

7th (Service) Battalion King's Shropshire Light Infantry

Died of Wounds; France 15th July 1916 Age 32

Killed in action; France 2 November 1915 Aged 22

Killed in action; France 3 March 1917 Aged 20

Buried in Fouquescourt British Cemetery, France.

1st Battalion King's Shropshire Light Infantry

Killed in Action; France 8th October 1918 Age 21

Buried in Ramicourt British Cemetery, Aisne, France

**Arthur Davies** Gunner No. 69334

99th Siege Battery Royal Garrison Artillery

Killed in action; France 2 July 1918 Aged 27

Buried in Les Baraques Military Cemetery, Sangatte, Pas de Calais, France

**David Davies** Driver No. 36837

B Battery, 79th Brigade Royal Field Artillery

Killed in action; France 17 April 1917 Aged 29

Buried in Faubourg D'Amiens Cemetery Arras, Pas de Calais, France

**Leonard Edge** Shoeing Smith No. L/9936

149th Brigade Royal Field Artillery

Died; United Kingdom (Sheffield) 6 March 1916 Aged 36

Buried in Urmston Cemetery, Lancashire

**James Evans** Private No. 8932

A Company, 2nd Battalion Royal Welsh Fusiliers

Died of wounds; France 23 May 1915 Aged 29

Buried in Erquinghem-Lys Churchyard Extension, France

**John Evans** Private No. 16514

D Company, 5th Battalion King's Shropshire Light Infantry

Died of wounds; France 22 April 1916 Aged 33

Buried in St Hilaire Cemetery, Frevent, France

**Edgar Fleet** Private No. 21235

7th Battalion King's Shropshire Light Infantry

Killed in action; France 9 April 1917 Aged 23

Commemorated on Arras Memorial, Pas de Calais, France

**Wilfred Fleet** 2nd Corporal No. 251785

1st Army Workshop Company 8 Royal Engineers (formerly 19755 King's Shropshire Light Infantry)

Died; UK 10 May 1920 Aged 25

Buried in Malpas Cemetery, Cheshire

**Patrick Gavien** (*listed as Gavin on war memorial*) Corporal No. 1973

1st Battalion Irish Guards

We have been unable to determine when or how he died

Killed in action; France 7 October 1916 Aged 26

Commemorated on Thiepval Memorial

Nigerian Regiment, West African Frontier Force (previously 3rd Battalion King's Shropshire Light Infantry)

Died of illness; UK 7 April 1919 Aged 23

Buried in Brecon Cemetery, Powys, Wales

15th Battalion Cheshire Regiment; formerly 223555 Labour Corps

Killed in action; Belgium 14 October 1918 Aged 22

Buried in Dadizeele New British Cemetery, Belgium

Killed in action; France 17 April 1917 Aged 23

Buried in Faubourg D'Amiens Cemetery, Arras, Pas de Calais, France.

Died of wounds; France 9 November 1916 Aged 36

Buried in Boulogne Eastern Cemetery, Pas de Calais, France.

Died of illness; United Kingdom 13 May 1917 Aged 20

Died of illness; UK 13 April 1919 Aged 28

Killed in action; France 22 October 1918 Aged 27

Buried in Belle Vue British Cemetery, Briastre, Nord, France.

1st/7th Battalion Cheshire Regiment

Killed in action; Palestine 17 December 1917 Aged 23

Buried in Jerusalem War Cemetery, Palestine.

820th Mechanical Transport Company, Army Service Corps

Died of illness (malaria); Greece 21 March 1918 Aged 38

Buried in Salonika (Lembet Road) Military Cemetery, Greece

21st/25th Battalion Australian Infantry

Killed in action; France 4 July 1918 Aged 30

Buried in Crucifix Corner Cemetery, Villers-Bretonneux, France

Died of wounds; France 10 May 1918 Aged 31

Buried in Boulogne Eastern Cemetery, Pas de Calais, France

Died at sea; Persian Gulf 13 February 1917 Aged 36

Commemorated on Basra Memorial, Iraq

1st Battalion King's Own Scottish Borderers

Died of wounds; Belgium 11 April 1918 Aged 33

Commemorated on Ploegsteert Memorial, Hainault, Belgium

20th Battalion The King's (Liverpool Regiment)

Killed in Action; France 1 July 1916 Aged 35

Commemorated on Thiepval Memorial

Killed in action; France 21 March 1918 Aged 27

Commemorated on Pozieres Memorial, Somme, France.

Killed in action; France 24 August 1916 Aged 18

Commemorated on Thiepval Memorial

Died of wounds; France 22 August 1918 Aged 20

Buried in St Hilaire Cemetery Extension, Frevant, Pas de Calais, France.

1st/4th Battalion Wiltshire Regiment, formerly Cheshire Regiment (4677)

Died of illness (malaria); Egypt 18 October 1917 Aged 33

Buried in Alexandria (Hadra) War Memorial Cemetery, Egypt

**Joseph Stevenson** Private No. 16591

6th Battalions King's Shropshire Light Infantry

Killed in Action; France 12 October 1915 Aged 21

Buried in Rue-du-Bacquerot No 1 Military Cemetery, Laventie, France

**John Richard Taylor** Private No. 90622

3rd Battalion Royal Welsh Fusiliers

Died; 20 November 1918 Aged 20

Buried in Malpas Cemetery, Malpas, Cheshire

**Alfred Walley** Sergeant No. S/11198

13th Battalion Rifle Brigade

Killed in action; France 14 November 1916 Aged 25

Commemorated on Thiepval Memorial

**Leonard Wasse** Sapper No. 480462, formerly 3402

460th Field Company Royal Engineers

Died of wounds; France 19 August 1917 Aged 33

Buried in Favreuil British Cemetery, Pas de Calais, France

**George Williamson** Private No. 24397

8th Battalion King's Shropshire Light Infantry

Killed in action; Greece 18 September 1918 Aged 22

Buried in Doiran Military Cemetery, Greece.

**Richard Williamson** Private No. 24219

8th Battalion Cheshire Regiment

Killed in action; Mesopotamia (Iraq) 20 December 1916 Aged 26

Commemorated on Basra Memorial, Iraq

**Douglas Kirk Wolley-Dod** Lieutenant No.

12th Battalion The King's (Liverpool Regiment)

Killed in action; France 25 September 1915 Aged 18

Buried in Rue-Petillon Military Cemetery, Fleurbaix, France

**Frederick Hova Wolley-Dod** Lieutenant No.

1st Garrison Battalion King's Own Yorkshire Light Infantry

Died of illness (typhoid); Macedonia, now Turkey, 24 July 1919 Aged 47

Buried in Chanak Consular Cemetery, Turkey

**George Albert Woodfield** Private No. 230789

4th Reserve Battalion King's Shropshire Light Infantry (formerly 1178 Cheshire Yeomanry)

Died; UK 24 November 1918 Aged 29

Buried in Malpas Cemetery, Malpas, Cheshire

**Alfred Wragg** Aircraftman 2nd class No. 67787

3rd Balloon Wing Royal Air Force

Died of illness; France 3 March 1919 Aged 36

Buried in Longuenesse (St Omer) Souvenir Cemetery Pas de Calais, France.

**NOTE\*** Not all the Service Men with Malpas connections who gave their lives are commemorated on our Malpas War memorial.

There are 9 missing men, these being: Percy Chapman, Ernest Holland, Wilfred Simon Hopley, Ernest Oswald Jones, Laurence Reddrop Lewis,

George Mackay, Alfred Ridgway, John Roberts, Robert Brock Stewart,

The Commonwealth War Graves Commission CWGC website also confirms that there are 7 WW1 CWGC burials in the Malpas cemetery, these being: Alfred Ashley, Wilfred Fleet, Wilfred Simon Hopley, Thomas Ivan Jones, Robert Brock Stewart, John Richard Taylor and George Albert Woodfield.
