1st Battalion Cheshire Regiment Killed in action: Belgium 24 August 1914. Aged 28 Buried in Audregnies Communal Cemetery, Belgium.

Robert Ankers Rifleman No. 372125, (previously 4581)

8th Battalion London Regiment (Post Office Rifles) Killed in action: France (Battle of the Somme) 7 October 1916. Aged 34 Buried in Warlencourt British Cemetery, Pas de Calais, France.

Alfred Ashley Private No. 202832

Depot Royal Welch Fusiliers Died of wounds sustained in Palestine: Chester 6 March 1919. Aged 27 Buried in Malpas Cemetery.

John (Alfred) Bailey Able Seaman No. R/3713

Howe Battalion, Royal Navy Division, Royal Naval Volunteer Reserve Died of wounds: France 5 January 1918. Aged 25 Buried in Rocquigny-Equancourt Road British Cemetery, Manancourt, Somme, France.

Sydney Barlow Private No. 9453

2nd Battalion Royal Welch Fusiliers Killed in action: France 30 October 1914. Aged 29 Buried in Pont-du-Hem Military Cemetery, La Gorgue, Nord, France. **Frederick Bateman** Rifleman No. 4302 1st/8th Battalion London Regiment (Post Office Rifles) Killed in action: France 21 May 1916. Aged 29 Commemorated on Arras Memorial, Pas de Calais, France.

Charles Bebbington Private No. 15034 (previously 4685)

South Wales Borderers, posted to 2nd Battalion Monmouthshire Regiment Killed in action: France 16 January 1917. Aged 21 Commemorated on Thiepval Memorial, Somme, France.

James (Albert) Benyon Private No. 718262 (previously 371761)

23rd Battalion London Regiment Died of wounds: France 9 May 1918. Aged 34 Buried in Senlis Communal Cemetery Extension, Somme, France.

William Birchall Private No. 34582

C Company 13th Battalion Gloucestershire Regiment Died of wounds: France 31 March 1918. Aged 32 Buried in Namps-au-Val British Cemetery, France.

George Boycott Private No. 61135

13th Battalion Welch Regiment Died from drowning, Pembrokeshire 21 September 1919. Aged 20 Buried in Pembroke Dock Military Cemetery, Wales.

Thomas Boycott Private No. 18499

C Company 7th Battalion King's Shropshire Light Infantry Killed in action: France (Battle of the Somme) 14 July 1916. Aged 22 Commemorated on Thiepval Memorial, Somme, France.

William (John) Brellisford Private No. 48750

6th Battalion Royal Inniskilling Fusiliers (previously 32767 Cheshire Regiment) Died of wounds: France 16 November 1918. Aged 36 Buried in Premont British Cemetery, Aisne, France.

John (Henry) Burns Gunner No. 3917 (although shown as 1917 on the CWGC site)

'X' 4th Trench Mortar Battery, Royal Field Artillery Died from unknown cause due to war service: Whitchurch, Shropshire 1 May 1920. Aged 25 Buried in Whitchurch Cemetery, Shropshire.

James Caughan (now identified as James Gaughan) Private No. 14403

7th (Service) Battalion King's Shropshire Light Infantry Died of Wounds: France (Battle of the Somme) 15 July 1916. Age 32 Buried in La-Neuville British Cemetery, Corbie, Somme, France.

Ambrose Chetwood Private No. W/908

13th Battalion Cheshire Regiment Killed in action: France 2 November 1915. Aged 22 Buried in Etaples Military Cemetery, Pas de Calais, France.

Edgar (Henry) Clutton Private No. 50297 (also 5040 and 241788)

16th Battalion Cheshire Regiment Killed in action: France 3 March 1917. Aged 20 Buried in Fouquescourt British Cemetery, France.

James Crump Private No. 10464 1st Battalion King's Shropshire Light Infantry Killed in action: France 8 October 1918. Aged 21 Buried in Ramicourt British Cemetery, Aisne, France.

Arthur Davies Gunner No. 69334

99th Siege Battery Royal Garrison Artillery Died from gas poisoning in hospital: France 2 July 1918. Aged 27 Buried in Les Baraques Military Cemetery, Sangatte, Pas de Calais, France.

David Davies Driver No. 36837

B Battery, 79th Brigade Royal Field Artillery Killed in action: France 17 April 1917. Aged 29 Buried in Faubourg D'Amiens Cemetery Arras, Pas de Calais, France.

Leonard Edge Shoeing Smith No. L/9936 149th Brigade Royal Field Artillery Died of wounds: Sheffield 6 March 1916. Aged 36 Buried in Urmston Cemetery, Lancashire.

James Evans Private No. 8932

A Company, 2nd Battalion Royal Welch Fusiliers Died of wounds: France 23 May 1915. Aged 29 Buried in Erquinghem-Lys Churchyard Extension, France.

John Evans Private No. 16514

D Company, 5th Battalion King's Shropshire Light Infantry Died of wounds; France 22 April 1916. Aged 33 Buried in St Hilaire Cemetery, Frevent, France.

Edgar Fleet Private No. 21235

7th Battalion King's Shropshire Light Infantry Killed in action: France 9 April 1917. Aged 23 Commemorated on Arras Memorial, Pas de Calais, France.

Wilfred Fleet 2nd Corporal No. 251785

1st Army Workshop Company 8 Royal Engineers (previously 19755 King's Shropshire Light Infantry) Died from heat stroke after suffering from exhaustion: Malpas 10 May 1920. Aged 25 Buried in Malpas Cemetery.

Patrick Gavin (listed as Patrick Gavien in some records) Corporal No. 1973

1st Battalion Irish Guards Died at a still unknown location shortly before Armistice was signed There is no Commonwealth War Grave Commission record for him.

Stephen Gibbons Private No. 10976

16th (The Queen's) Lancers, Household Cavalry Killed in action: France 23 March 1918. Aged 40 Commemorated on Pozieres Memorial, Somme, France.

George Glover Sergeant No 10058

1st Battalion King's Shropshire Light Infantry Killed in action: Belgium 31 May 1918. Aged 24 Buried in Nine Elms British Cemetery, West-Vlaanderem, Belgium.

John Glover (known as Jack) Lance Corporal No. G/566

6th Battalion The Buffs (East Kent Regiment) Killed in action: France (Battle of the Somme) 7 October 1916. Aged 26 Commemorated on Thiepval Memorial. Somme, France.

Joseph Groom DCM (Distinguished Conduct Medal) Colour Sergeant No. 9865 (KSLI number)

Nigerian Regiment, West African Frontier Force (previously 3rd Battalion King's Shropshire Light Infantry) Died of malaria contracted in West Africa: Brecon 7 April 1919. Aged 23 Buried in Brecon Cemetery, Wales.

Joseph Hewitt Private No. 19241

15th Battalion Cheshire Regiment; previously 223555 Labour Corps Killed in action: Belgium 14 October 1918. Aged 22 Buried in Dadizeele New British Cemetery, Belgium.

John Hopley Driver No. 36834

B Battery, 79th Brigade Royal Field Artillery Killed in action: France 17 April 1917. Aged 23 Buried in Faubourg D'Amiens Cemetery, Arras, Pas de Calais, France.

John Johnson (known as Jack) Private No. 26300

9th Battalion Cheshire Regiment Died of wounds: France (Battle of the Somme) 9 November 1916. Aged 36 Buried in Boulogne Eastern Cemetery, Pas de Calais, France.

John (Owen) Jones Private No. 40096

3rd Battalion South Lancashire RegimentDied of meningitis: Barrow in Furness 13 May 1917. Aged 20Buried in Mostyn (Christ Church) Churchyard, Flintshire, Wales.

Thomas (Ivan) Jones Able Seaman No. 237257 (CH)

HM Torpedo Boat "No 36", Hecla, Royal Navy Died of pneumonia: Edinburgh 13 April 1919. Aged 28 Buried in Malpas Cemetery.

Harry Lamb Private No. 37323

1st/7th Battalion Lancashire Fusiliers (previously 1872 Cheshire Yeomanry) Killed in action: France 22 October 1918. Aged 27 Buried in Belle Vue British Cemetery, Briastre, Nord, France. **Frank Leek** Private No. 291498, (previously 4290) 1st/7th Battalion Cheshire Regiment Killed in action: Palestine 17 December 1917. Aged 23 Buried in Jerusalem War Cemetery, Palestine.

Samuel Marsh Private No. M2/203330

820th Mechanical Transport Company, Army Service Corps Died of malaria: Greece 21 March 1918. Aged 38 Buried in Salonika (Lembet Road) Military Cemetery, Greece.

Archibald (Maltman) McIntyre Private No. 7089

21st/25th Battalion Australian Infantry Killed in action: France 4 July 1918. Aged 30 Buried in Crucifix Corner Cemetery, Villers-Bretonneux, France.

John McMichael Gunner No. 112440

119th Siege Battery Royal Garrison Artillery Died of wounds: France 10 May 1918. Aged 31 Buried in Boulogne Eastern Cemetery, Pas de Calais, France.

John Mercer Private No. 44764

4th Battalion South Wales Borderers Died at sea: Persian Gulf 13 February 1917. Aged 36 Commemorated on Basra Memorial, Iraq.

George Parker Private No. 25387

1st Battalion King's Own Scottish Borderers Died of wounds: Belgium 11 April 1918. Aged 33 Commemorated on Ploegsteert Memorial, Hainault, Belgium. Arthur Phillips Company Quartermaster, Sergeant No. 22810 20th Battalion The King's (Liverpool Regiment) Killed in action: France (Battle of the Somme) 1 July 1916. Aged 35 Commemorated on Thiepval Memorial, Somme, France.

John Powell Private No. 17988

5th Battalion King's Shropshire Light Infantry Killed in action: France (Battle of the Somme) 24 August 1916. Aged 18 Commemorated on Thiepval Memorial, Somme, France.

(Charles) John Richardson Lance Sergeant No. 14/599

14th Battalion York and Lancaster Regiment Killed in action: France (Battle of the Somme) 28 August 1916. Aged 23 Buried at St Vaast Post Military Cemetery, Richeborg-l'Avoure, Pas de Calais, France.

Hugh (Handley) Sandbach Captain and Commanding Officer

East African Mounted Rifles, previously 1st Royal Dragoons Killed in action: Tanzania 3 November 1914. Aged 36 Buried in Dar Es Salaam War Cemetery, Tanzania.

Richard Simpson Driver No. 198270

282nd Brigade Royal Field Artillery Died of wounds: France 22 August 1918. Aged 20 Buried in St Hilaire Cemetery Extension, Frevent, Pas de Calais, France.

Edward Stevenson Private No. 203653

1st/4th Battalion Wiltshire Regiment, previously Cheshire Regiment (4677) Died of malaria: Egypt 18 October 1917. Aged 33 Buried in Alexandria (Hadra) War Memorial Cemetery, Egypt.

Joseph Stevenson Private No. 16591

6th Battalion King's Shropshire Light Infantry Killed in action: France 12 October 1915. Aged 21 Buried in Rue-du-Bacquerot No 1 Military Cemetery, Laventie, France.

John (Richard) Taylor Private No. 90622

3rd Battalion Royal Welch Fusiliers Died of pneumonia: Ireland 20 November 1918. Aged 20 Buried in Malpas Cemetery.

Alfred Walley Sergeant No. S/11198

13th Battalion Rifle Brigade Killed in action: France (Battle of the Somme) 14 November 1916. Aged 25 Commemorated on Thiepval Memorial, Somme, France.

Leonard Wasse Sapper No. 480462, (previously 3402) 460th Field Company Royal Engineers Died of wounds: France 19 August 1917. Aged 33 Buried in Favreuil British Cemetery, Pas de Calais, France.

George Williamson Private No. 24397 8th Battalion King's Shropshire Light Infantry Killed in action: Greece 18 September 1918. Aged 22 Buried in Doiran Military Cemetery, Greece.

Richard Williamson Private No. 24219 8th Battalion Cheshire Regiment Killed in action: Iraq 20 December 1916. Aged 26 Commemorated on Basra Memorial, Iraq.

Douglas (Kirk) Wolley-Dod Lieutenant

12th Battalion The King's (Liverpool Regiment) Killed in action: France 25 September 1915. Aged 18 Buried in Rue-Petillon Military Cemetery, Fleurbaix, France.

Frederic (Hova) Wolley-Dod Lieutenant

1st Garrison Battalion King's Own Yorkshire Light Infantry Died of typhoid: Turkey 24 July 1919. Aged 47 Buried in Chanak Consular Cemetery, Turkey.

George (Albert) Woodfield Private No. 230789

4th Reserve Battalion King's Shropshire Light Infantry (previously 1178 Cheshire Yeomanry) Died of illness returning from Western Front: Pembroke Dock 24 November 1918. Aged 29 Buried in Malpas Cemetery.

Alfred Wragg Aircraftman 2nd class No. 67787

3rd Balloon Wing Royal Air ForceDied of pneumonia: France 3 March 1919. Aged 36Buried in Longuenesse (St Omer) Souvenir Cemetery Pas de Calais, France.
